



Fall 2020 Lit Drop Canvasser Job Description:

We are looking for passionate and reliable individuals to join our team of advocates and champions for issues of social justice and environmental conservation. Must be based in Anchorage and have reliable transportation and willing to work independently. This is a temporary seasonal position that will run from approximately September 1 through mid-November.

Canvassers will be provided necessary Personal Protective Equipment including masks and gloves and will be required to follow all CDC guidelines when conducting literature drop campaigns. Canvassers must be familiar with using app-based platforms and maps.

This is an entry-level position that provides career-building opportunities in a larger conservation and social justice movement.

Duties Include (but are not limited to):

- Leaving flyers on doors about safe civic engagement and/or taking action with a campaign
- Recording accurate data, and working with their supervisor to ensure quality and accuracy
- Being flexible, as we are operating in changing and unknown times

The ideal candidate would:

- Have experience canvassing, door knocking, phone banking or working with the public
- Have excellent intrapersonal skills
- Be independent, accountable and honest
- Have experience working with technology and data entry
- Have reliable transportation

The salary is dependent on experience and starts at \$17/ hour. Work hours will be flexible, generally Sundays through Thursdays Noon to 4pm but are subject to change. Positions are open until filled. You must be 18 years of age or older to apply for this position and have reliable transportation. Mileage and technology reimbursements are available.
