What is Solarize Fairbanks?

Solarize Fairbanks is an all volunteer campaign making it easier and more affordable to go solar in the Fairbanks North Star Borough. Modeled after Solarize campaigns in Anchorage and the Lower 48, we work with local residents and installers to achieve volume discounts on solar photovoltaic (PV) systems that will produce energy and CO₂ savings for years to come.

Who can participate?

Homeowners, businesses, churches and other nonprofits in Fairbanks and North Pole. Solarize groups have formed in four areas of the Borough from Ester to Salcha. People should join their nearest group.

How much can you save?

Solarize Fairbanks homeowners and businesses are saving over 25% on the installed cost of systems compared with 2019. They will also receive a 26% federal tax credit for solar PV purchases made in 2020.

How are savings achieved?

Hardware costs for solar PV systems have come down sharply over the last 20 years, while “soft costs” (labor, customer acquisition and overhead) have stayed the same. Solarize campaigns save installers time and money on customer acquisition and education. Savings are passed on to solarizers through a competitive bid process.

Why Solarize?

Reduce CO₂ by over 1,000 lbs per year for every 1 kW of solar PV in Fairbanks.




This is the year. Solarize Fairbanks is the way.

It's never been this cheap or this easy to GO SOLAR in Interior Alaska.

The cost of solar PV has dropped 70% just since 2010. If you purchase in 2020, not only will you save over 25% on the installed cost by buying through Solarize Fairbanks, you'll get a 26% tax credit—a direct dollar-for-dollar reduction off your federal taxes. That credit drops to 22% in 2021 and disappears in 2022.

Absolutely! Because our energy costs are high, Fairbanksans save more each year from investing in solar than people in Miami, Phoenix, or Los Angeles. That doesn't even count the credit we receive for solar electricity sold back to GVEA at 10 cents/kWh, as of March 2020.
